
CROSS HATCHING


Cross hatching is the technique in drawing or graphics, of shading an area with intersecting sets of parallel lines.

Create a value scale using cross hatching. Place intersecting parallel lines close together to create dark values and farther apart to create light values.

DARK —			→ LIGHT

2 Use the <u>light</u> guidelines to recreate the sphere in the box to the right.






*REMEMBER: Use cross hatching to create a contour line. Cross hatching uses intersecting parallel lines only (in two directions).

3 Use the <u>light</u> guidelines to shade the apple with cross hatching.
